USER FAQs

How do I access ATIS Learning?

After launch ATIS Learning will be accessible directly at learn.atis.army.mil or via redirect from the ALMS website.

What is ATIS Learning?

ATIS Learning is your modernized Learning Management System (LMS) replacing ALMS 4.0 and will provide an upgraded user interface and experience.

Why is the Army changing learning management systems?

The current Army Learning Management System (ALMS), Saba, is reaching its end-of-life and needs to be replaced. The new modernized ALMS platform addresses the growing needs of Soldiers and Department of Army Civilians. These needs include an improved ease of use with a personalized, intuitive user experience.

When will ATIS Learning be available?

ATIS Learning will be available on March 29th at 1700ET.

ATIS Learning was scheduled to be released in January. Why has the release been delayed?

Following a deployment readiness review, the launch for ATIS Learning was delayed to allow additional time to migrate legacy training records.

When will ALMS shut down?

ALMS will go offline on March 22nd at 1700ET and will remain offline for one week until ATIS Learning is Launched on March 29th.

Why is an Offline Period needed?

The offline period is needed to complete go-live activities. These activities include moving learner information from ALMS 4.0 to ATIS Learning. Learning information includes course, topic, and learning activity completions and certificates.

What needs to be completed before the offline period begins?

Learners are encouraged to complete any inprogress courses prior to 22 March to prepare for the data migration required to launch ATIS Learning.

What happens if I don't finish my in-progress learning activities prior to ALMS going offline?

If a learning activity is not completed prior to ALMS going offline it will not be moved to ATIS Learning. Only completed learning activities will be moved to ATIS Learning. You will have to restart the activity in ATIS Learning when the new system is released.

Will existing enrollments and past course completion information be available in ATIS Learning?

Existing enrollments and course completions will be available immediately for all users that have logged into ALMS in the past 12 months. Users that have not logged into the system in the past 12 months will be able to request an on-demand import of their records when initially logging into ATIS Learning via an automated data migration prompt.
