ATIS Prototype Contract Awarded

NEWPORT NEWS, Virginia. – The U.S. Army Program Executive Office Enterprise Information Systems (PEO EIS) recently awarded three competitive prototype contracts to address risk reduction and provide technology demonstrations for the Army Training Information System (ATIS) project, part of the Product Manager ATIS. The awards are firm fixed price through the use of other transaction agreements, and administered through the C5 Consortium Management Group. Each agreement is for a 12-month period of performance.

Contracts for prototypes were awarded to CGI Federal Inc., Enterprise Services LLC, and KBRwyle Inc. The prototypes are the first step for ATIS to partner with industry to optimize Soldiers and civilians' ability to plan, prepare, execute and assess training, education and leader development across the operational, institutional and self-development training domains. Additionally, the prototype awards will leverage technologies for the collection, processing, maintenance, use, sharing and dissemination of training information.

Current training information systems lack enterprise visibility, accessibility, governance, and security. ATIS will address these issues by making education and training data accessible, understandable, trusted, interoperable, and responsive to user needs. ATIS will provide a single-entry, integrated system, comprised of any combination of commercial off-the-shelf, government off-the-shelf, and existing software/ hardware products and services. ATIS is a defense business system that will provide a common operational picture of the Army training environment in five integrated and interoperable capability areas: training development, training management, enterprise scheduling, content management and resource management. Working with industry partners will enable ATIS to provide an optimal training experience for all Soldiers and civilians across the Army enterprise.
